

THE PRINCE'S TRUST GROUP FACTSHEET 2020/21

The Prince's Trust Group is a global network of charities founded by HRH The Prince of Wales in 1976. Together, our mission is to transform lives and build sustainable communities worldwide, with a particular focus on empowering young people.

We are active in 18 countries, both within the Commonwealth and beyond. During 2020/21, we supported just over **60,000 young people** in 16 countries: **Australia, Barbados, Canada, Ghana, Greece, India, Jamaica, Jordan, Kenya, Malaysia, Malta, New Zealand, Pakistan, Rwanda, Trinidad & Tobago** and the **UK**. We have also begun our work in **St Lucia** and the **USA**.

In a rapidly changing world, we deliver Education, Employment, Enterprise and Environmental projects that enable young people and communities to thrive.

We are focused primarily on transforming lives by enabling young people between the ages 11 to 30 to complete their journey from education to employment. We help young people to develop their confidence and life skills, to access education and training, and to move into employment and self-employment. In Australia and Canada, we also support military veterans into self-employment after leaving the armed forces.

The Prince's Trust Group includes the work of The Prince's Trust in the UK alongside Prince's Trust International, Prince's Trust Australia, Prince's Trust New Zealand, Prince's Trust Canada and Prince's Trust USA.

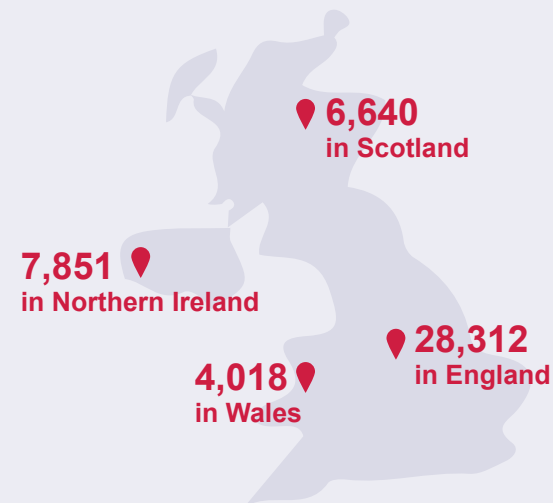

Prince's Trust across the UK in 2020/21

In 2020/21 we supported 46,834 individual young people in the UK (78% of the total). Of these, 32,595 young people were new to The Trust and 14,239 young people received ongoing support from us, having started in previous years.

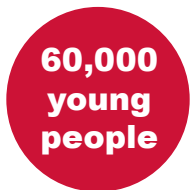

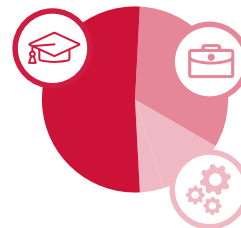

We supported just over **60,000 young people** during 2020/21, including almost **47,000 in the UK** and just over **13,000 outside the UK**.

Outside of the UK, two-thirds of the young people we supported identified as female.



Outside the UK, **83%** of the 13,000 young people we supported were engaged online. This was mainly in response to the coronavirus pandemic.
